

End of the Year One Pager Project

A one-pager is a collage of illustrations and written analyses on one page that make up an aesthetically pleasing and detailed interpretation of a subject or piece of literature.

Directions: Imaginatively blend your thoughts and ideas with colorful images based on this school year, this summer, and next school year. You should spend at least thirty minutes brainstorming ideas before you begin decorating your page. Use a standard size piece of blank paper (8.5 x 11) or you may use a template provided for you. Below is a list of what should be included on your page:

- your first and last name.
- four or more illustrations/graphic images.
- three words that describe your experience this school year.
- Describe your favorite memory from this year.
- Explain one thing you are looking forward to next year.
- Describe two goals or plans you have for this summer.
- Identify one song that you feel summarizes this year for you OR was important to you this year.
- Include one piece of advice you have for next year's students.
- Include one important lesson you have learned this year about yourself.

You must fill the entire page. Your page must be colored.
